

NCVF BEST PRACTICES

WOMEN EVENT DESIGNATION

ALL NCVF WOMEN'S TOURNAMENT TEAMS MUST MEET THE NCVF PLAYER AND TEAM ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS. RESULTS FROM TOURNAMENTS/TEAMS THAT ARE NOT IN COMPLIANCE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR RANKING/QUALIFYING EVENTS FOR THE NCVF NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.

TOURNAMENT (T):

- May be held at any time.
- Must be registered on the NCVF website.
- May or may not include a Site Supervisor who submits results for the event to the NCVF Ranking Committee. Tournament results may or may not be weighted as heavily for regular season national rankings.
- May include non-NCVF and/or USAV teams.
- May include any number of participating teams.
- May or may not ensure match play for all matches, and may or may not adhere to official NCVF format, rules and scoring guidelines.
- May or may not include USAV certified officials for all matches, though certified officials are strongly encouraged.

NCVF STANDARD TOURNAMENT (ST):

- Must occur during the NCVF regular season.
- Must be registered on the NCVF website.
- Pre-tournament seeding should be done by a member of the NCVF women's ranking committee
- May include a Site Supervisor who is responsible for compiling and submitting results to the appropriate NCVF Ranking Committee within 48hours of the event's completion.
- Should ensure match play (preferred method best 2/3 games but may deviate due to time constraints) for ALL matches and adhere to official NCVF format, rules and scoring guidelines for ALL matches.
- Must include at least one USAV certified official minimum for the semi's and finals (preferably 1 for all play-off matches).

NCVF RANKING TOURNAMENT (RT)

- Must occur during the NCVF regular season (Jan. 1 – April 30)
- Must fill out the NCVF ranking tournament application and meet all the standards set forth therein. There are limited ranking tournaments approved each year (based on geography, courts, ease of travel) and apply to host does not guarantee you will be chosen.

NCVF LEAGUE PLAY (L):

- Must occur during the NCVF regular season (Jan. 1 – April 30)
- Must be scheduled through NCVF member leagues.
- Must include a Site Supervisor/commissioner who is responsible for compiling and submitting results to the respective NCVF league and/or NCVF Ranking Committee within 48 hours of the event's completion.
- Must ensure match play (preferred method best 2/3 games but may deviate due to time constraints) games for ALL matches and adhere to official NCVF format, rules and scoring guidelines.
- Must include at least one USAV certified official for every match.
